

Submission from K3S Class Fleming Fulton on a Bill of Rights

Six students participated in this consultation: John, Shane, Aaron, Eoin, Natasha and Lindsay. They are all aged between 14- 15 years of age. All of the students are non-verbal and communicate with communication boards; one student, Shane, uses an electronic communication aid.

The consultation involved an initial introductory session and three consultation sessions. The sessions were jointly facilitated by Ms. Dorteia Simpson Class Teacher and Ms. Sara Boyce NI Human Rights Commission. Support was also provided to the students by two care workers.


































The students focused on the following areas

- Things I need every day

They communicated their responses individually using symbols on their communication boards/communication aid and Ms. Thompson then entered their responses onto a master table under the three different headings.

Notes to accompany response sheets:

- a) **PHAB** is a youth club run by Fleming Fulton in the grounds of the school. It is open to students, ex-students and young people living locally in the area.
- b) A **switch** allows the individual to operate computer programmes and/or an electronic wheelchair independently.
- c) **Wrestling and boxing** refer to watching these sports on TV.
- d) **Staying in the chalet** refers to the residential accommodation on the grounds of Fleming Fulton School that some students from outside of Belfast live in during the school term.

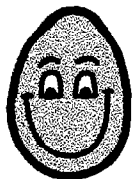
