

Rights for young people with disabilities

- We all have a right to access to buildings, facilities, and transport.

- Making buildings and transport accessible helps everybody, not just people with disabilities.
- The authorities should be forced to build ramps at schools.
- All public housing should be accessible.


Privacy

Education

- ✂✂ There is no real choice available to young people with disabilities at the moment as a lot of the support we need are only provided in special needs schools. Mainstream schools should cater for students with disabilities.
- ✂✂ The right to the National Curriculum, no matter which school you go to.
- ✂✂ Disability awareness training should be included on the curriculum.
